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PRESS RELEASE 1:

The project “ONE STEP UP” officially started in September 2022 and will be implemented until August 2024.

The project, led by the Lithuanian Partner Vsi Inovaciju Biuras involves partners from Ireland, Poland, Portugal, France, Croatia, Czech Republic and Cyprus.

The ONE-STEP UP project is an innovative project that aims to support Europe’s low-skilled adult learners to re-engage in education and training, by using micro-learning approaches to make adult education accessible and flexible, to encourage their participation. Throughout the course of the ONE-STEP UP project, project partners are working with front-line adult educators and low-skilled adults to provide them with the necessary knowledge and skills to participate in the labour market and improve their economic and social well-being.

To achieve these objectives, the project consortium will develop four project results:

- Educators toolbox of micro-learning resources
- Professional development training for front-line adult educators
- Adult educators handbook
- One Step Up MOOC
